Orders for the 2024 Tree Seedling Sale will be accepted through **Friday March 15, 2024** or until supplies are exhausted. Orders are taken on a first come, first served basis. All orders must be picked up at the District Office between **8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Friday April 5th or between 8:00 am –10:00 am Saturday April 6th.** Full payment must accompany all orders. Sorry, we cannot accept credit/debit cards.

**We are not responsible for packets not picked up on time. There are no refunds on orders of seedlings not picked up.**

<b>1 - White Pine:</b> <i>Pinus strobus</i> (10/ pkt) 4-0 yr (10"-20") Excellent for windbreak and hedges. Prefers acidic, well drained soils.	<b>2 - Colorado Blue Spruce:</b> <i>Picea pungens</i> (25/pkt) 3-yr (7"-15") Used for landscape, windbreaks, reforestation, and Christmas trees. Adaptable to variety of soils.
<b>3 - Norway spruce:</b> <i>Picea abies</i> (10/pkt) T2-2 (8"-16") Used for ornamentals, timber and wind/snow breaks. Adapts to variety of soil types.	<b>4 - Douglas Fir:</b> <i>Pseudotsuga menziesii glauca</i> (25/ pkt) 2-0 yr (10"-18") When grown in the open, makes a great windbreak, can handle wetter soils, full sun.
<b>5 - Scotch pine:</b> <i>Pinus sylvestris</i> (10/ pkt) 3-0 yr (10"-20") Hardy, short needle, blue-green. Good for timber, ornamental. Adapts to a variety of soil types.	<b>6 - Bald Cypress:</b> <i>Taxodium distichum</i> (25/ pkt), 1-0 yr (12"-18") Slow growing deciduous conifer that loves wet soil. Great for wildlife.
<b>7 - Tamarack (American Larch):</b> <i>Larix laricina</i> (25/pkt) 2-0 yr (12"-18") Great for wet areas. Fast growing, 80 ft mature height.	<b>8 - White Oak:</b> <i>Quercus alba</i> (5/pkt.) 1-0,2-0 yr (12"-18") Great for timber and wildlife. Prefers sun and drainage. Slow growth
<b>9 - Swamp White Oak:</b> <i>Quercus bicolor</i> (5/pkt.) 1-0,2-0 yr (12"-18") Slow grower. One of the best hardwood trees for wet woods.	<b>10 - Shumard Oak:</b> <i>Quercus shumardii</i> (5/pkt) 3 yr (24"-36") AKA Swamp Red Oak. Tolerates a wide variety of soil types, including poorly drained soils. Fast grower. High wildlife value.
<b>11 - Chinquapin Oak:</b> <i>Quercus muehlenbergii</i> (5/pkt) 3-0 yr (15"-30") Loves moist but well-drained soil. Resembles chestnut leaves. Fast grower.	<b>12 - Red Maple:</b> <i>Acer rubrum</i> (5/pkt) 2-0 yr (12"-18") Adaptable, but prefers moist or wet acidic soils. May want to protect from deer for the first couple of years.
<b>13 - Sugar Maple:</b> <i>Acer saccharum</i> (5/pkt) 2-0 yr (6"-12")   Adaptable to different soils, important for wildlife and pollinators.	<b>14 - Pin Cherry:</b> <i>Prunus pensylvanica</i> (5/pkt) 1-0 yr (18"-24")   Shrub or small tree. AKA fire cherry. Edible fruit. important for birds and pollinators. Short lived, but suckers to form thickets.
<b>15 - Common Paw Paw:</b> <i>Asimina triloba</i> (5/ pkt) 2-0 yr (12"-18") Slow growth, can take a little bit wetter soil. Edible fruit, wildlife, and pollinator use.	<b>16 - Speckled Alder:</b> <i>Alnus rugosa</i> (5/ pkt) 1-0 yr (12"-18") Great for wildlife and soil improvement. Adapts to a variety of soils, great for wildlife. Streambank stabilizer.
<b>17 - Red Mulberry:</b> <i>Morus Rubra</i> (5/pkt) 1-0 yr (12"-18") Great floodplain and moist hillside tree. Edible fruit, great for birds and pollinators.	<b>18 - Bitternut Hickory:</b> <i>Carya cordiformis</i> (5/ pkt) 2-0 yr (12"-18") AKA pignut hickory. Adaptable to different moist soils, full sun to part shade.
<b>19 - Sweetbay Magnolia:</b> <i>Magnolia virginiana</i> (5/ pkt) 2-0 yr (6"-12") Good wetland, rain garden and floodplain tree. Birds and pollinators love it. will do fine in shade.	<b>20 - White Flowering Dogwood:</b> <i>Cornus florida</i> (5/pkt) 1-0,2-0 yr (12"-18") Great for wildlife and soil improvement. They do best in well drained, pH 6-7, and temperature consistent soil.
<b>21 - Arrowwood:</b> <i>Viburnum dentatum</i> (5/ pkt) 1-0 yr (12"-18") Very adaptable, windbreak to streambank protection. Attractive flowers and fall foliage, great for wildlife. 3-9 ft tall, up to 8 ft spread.	<b>22 - Black Elderberry:</b> <i>Sambucus canadensis</i> (5/pkt) 1-0 yr (12"-18") Tolerates wide variety of soils, edible fruit, high wildlife value. 5-12 feet tall, usually wider than tall. Streambank stabilizer.
<b>23 - Highbush Blueberry:</b> <i>Vaccinium corymbosum</i> (5/pkt) RC+1 yr (6"-12") Tolerates wide variety of soils, edible fruit, high wildlife value. 6-12 feet tall shrub. Streambank stabilizer.	<b>24 - Highbush Cranberry:</b> <i>Viburnum trilobum</i> (5/pkt) 1-0 yr (12"-18") Tolerates wide variety of soils, edible fruit, high wildlife value. 8-12 feet tall shrub. Streambank stabilizer.
<b>25 - 55 gal plastic rain barrel with diverter kit, standard 2"x3" downspout size</b>	<b>26 - For Our Future - Bimundors Oak</b> grown by A-Tech from Snowy Oak Tree Farm acorns - donation to A-Tech & JWMS Fund
