2022 TREE SEEDLING SALE

Orders for the 2022 Tree Seedling Sale will be accepted through **Friday March 18, 2022** or until supplies are exhausted. Orders are taken on a first come, first served basis. All orders must be picked up at the District Office between **8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Friday April 8th or between 8:00 am –10:00 am Saturday April 9th.** Full payment must accompany all orders. Sorry, we cannot accept credit/debit cards.

We are not responsible for packets not picked up on time. There are no refunds on orders of seedlings not picked up.

All nursery stock sold through the Ashtabula SWCD is sold "as is" without warranty, expressed or implied as to quality, variety, description, or results from customer planting. Bare root nursery stock is perishable. All orders should be immediately and carefully taken to planting site to ensure the highest percent of survival as possible. Extra measures should be taken to avoid exposure to sun and wind while planting. All sales are final with no guarantee of survival.

: Tolerates wet soils : Native : Great for Pollinators

Packet 1&2- White Pine: *Pinus strobus* (25 per pkt.)

Excellent for windbreak and hedges. Prefers acidic, well drained soils. **This year we offer TWO SIZES! 3-0 YR 6"-10" or 5-0 12"-24"**



Packet 3- Colorado blue spruce: *Picea pungens* (25 per pkt.)

3-yr seedlings (10"-16") Used for landscape, windbreaks, reforestation and Christmas trees. Adaptable to variety of soils.

Packet 4- Norway spruce: *Picea abies* (25 per pkt.) Used for ornamentals, timber and wind/snow breaks. Adapts to variety of soil types. **3 or 5 YR 12"-24"**

Packet 5- Scotch pine: *Pinus sylvestris* (25 per pkt.) **3-yr seedlings (14"-18")** Hardy, short needle, blue-green. Good for timber, ornamental. Adapts to a variety of soil types.

Packet 6-White Spruce: *Picea glauca* (25 per pkt.) **3-yr seedlings (8"-14")** Thrives in well drained or moist soil. Extremely hardy and slowly grows to 50 ft. Stiff needles are light bluish-green usually less than 1" in length.

Packet 7- Arborvitae: *Thuja occidentalis* (25 per pkt.) **2-1yr seedlings (4"-6")** aka American Arborvitae. Growth: slow, maturity of 80 feet. Great for hedges and wildlife habitat, adapts to a variety of soils.



Packet 8- Fraser Fir: *Abies fraseri* (5 per pkt.) Does well in cool areas with rich well drained soil. Common in Christmas tree farms, rare in nature, this pyramidal conifer definitely doesn't like poorly drained soil.

Packet 9- American Sycamore: *Platanus occidentalis* (5 per pkt.) **2 yr (12"-24")** Loves those stream banks, flood plains, moist woods, and rich lowlands. A large tree for a large space. Great for birds.



Packet 10- Swamp White Oak: *Quercus bicolor* (5 per pkt.) **3 yr (24"-36")** Slow grower. One of the best hardwood trees for wet woods.



Packet 11- Red Maple: *Acer rubrum* (5 per pkt.) **3 yr (15-30")** Adaptable, but prefers moist or wet acidic soils. May want to protect from deer for the first couple of years.



Packet 12- White Flowering Dogwood: *Cornus florida* (5 per pkt.) **2 yr seedlings (10"-15")** Great for wildlife and ethnobotanists. They do best in well drained, pH 6-7, and temperature consistent soil.



Packet 13- American Hazelnut: *Corylus americana* Walter (5 per pkt.) **2 yr seedlings (15"-30")** More shrub, with a height of 10 ft. Great for wildlife, nuts are safe for humans. Adaptable to various conditions. Prolific colonizer.



Packet 14- American Cranberrybush: *Viburnum opulus L.* (5 per pkt.) **2 yr (4"-8")** Great for wet woods and along streams. More ornamental, but berries are edible.



Packet 15 – American Elder: *Sambucus canadensis* (5 per pkt.) **2 yr (10"-15")** Fast growing shrub, height of 10 ft. Great for wildlife, edible berries. Loves moist, sunny spots. Perfect for streambank protection.



Packet 16 – Common Paw Paw: *Asimina triloba* (5 per pkt.) **2 yr (6"-12")** Slow growth, can take a little bit wetter soil. Edible fruit, wildlife, and pollinator use.



Packet 17 – American Plum: *Prunus americana* (5 per pkt.) **1 yr seedlings (8"-12")** Likes moist, well drained soil. Edible fruit, wildlife, and pollinator use.



Packet 18 – River Birch: *Betula nigra* (5 per pkt.) **3 yr (24"-36")** Adaptable, but prefers acidic wet spots. Needs full sun. Seeds are eaten by birds. Medium to fast growth, gets to 50-70 ft tall, spread of 30-40 ft. Habitat for pollinators.



Packet 19 – Chokecherry: *Prunus virginiana* (5 per pkt.) **3-yr seedlings (12"-24")** Small suckering tree, 30 ft tall maximum. Important for wildlife and fruit can be made into jam/jelly. Seeds are toxic. Great windbreak, streambank stabilization. Spreads by rhizomes. Adaptable.
