Fall will be here before we know it! Now is the time to plan on preparing your pond for winter.

Triploid Grass Carp (White Amur) can be successfully used to control excessive amounts of pond vegetation as an alternative to chemicals, water shade and physical harvesting. Recommended stocking rates vary – many people recommend a flat rate of 10 fish per acre.

We are again offering fathead minnows for fall stocking. This is a great baitfish for catfish, bass, and bluegill. Even if your bluegill population is well established, minnows can be added to the forage base.

On pick-up day, please bring a clean container of <u>your own pond water</u>. You must bring one 5-gallon bucket per 1000 minnows ordered. For white Amur, bring one 5-gallon for every two fish ordered. Line each container with an <u>UNSCENTED</u>, <u>HEAVY DUTY garbage bag</u>, and fill containers 1/3 full with water and tie bag shut but be able to untie when arrive.
